

Months of Mugs – July Ice Pop

Cut the following:

Red

A 3 1/2 x 3 1/2" 1

Ice White

B 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" 1

C 1 1/2 x 5 1/2" 1

Turquoise Blue

D 2 1/2 x 5 1/2" 1

Light Brown

E 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" 1

White (for mug)

G 3 1/2 x 4 1/2" 2

H 2 1/2 x 3 1/2" 2

I 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" 2

J 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 4

White (for handle)

S 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 4

T 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" 2

U 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" 1

Grey (handle and above & below mug)

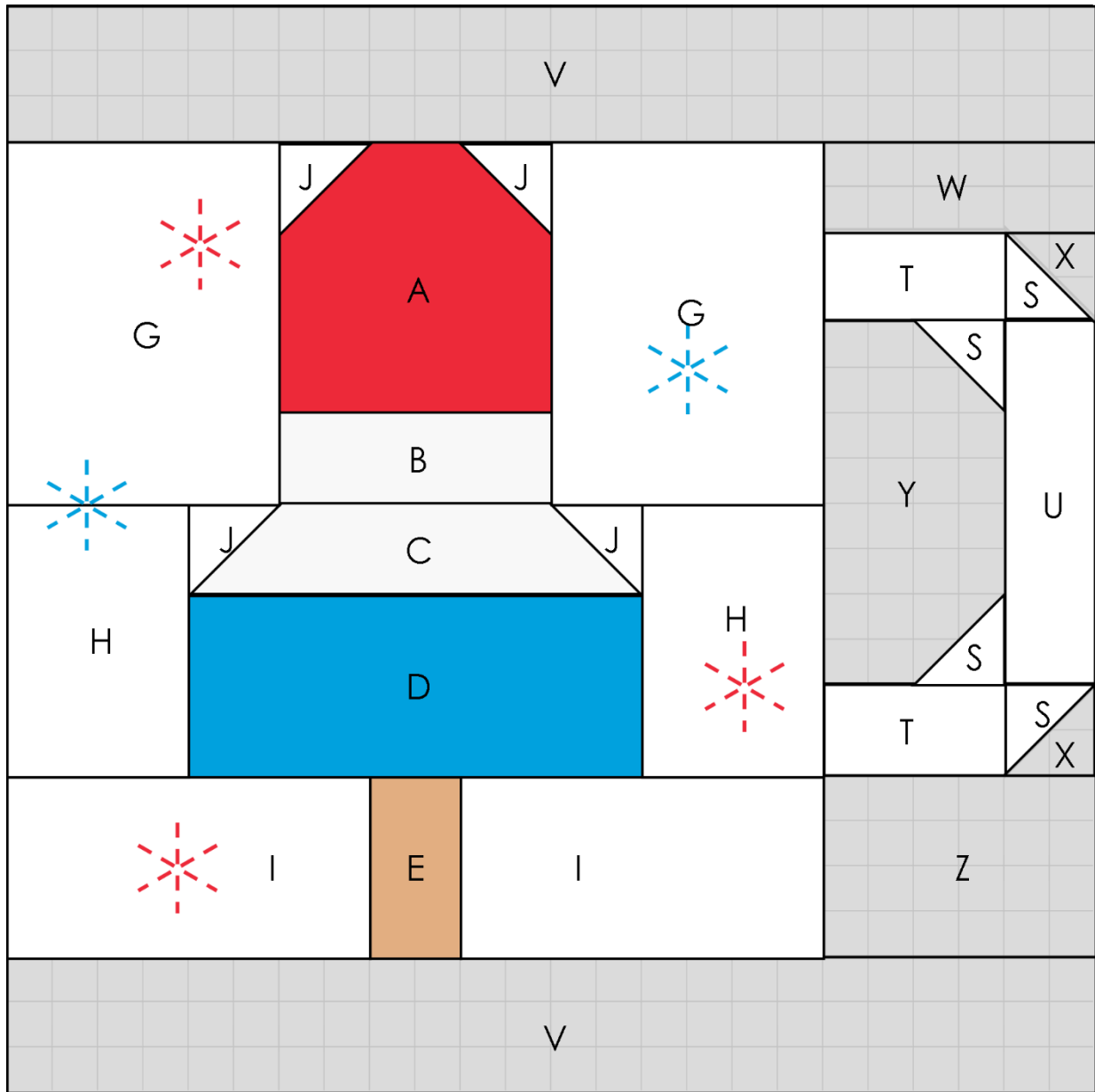
V 2 x 12 1/2" 2

W 1 1/2 x 3 1/2" 1

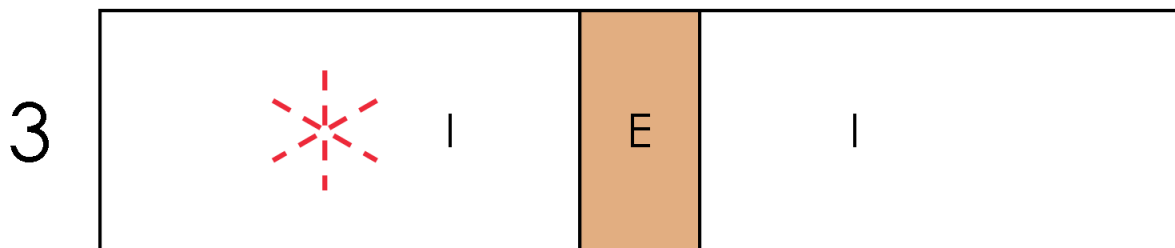
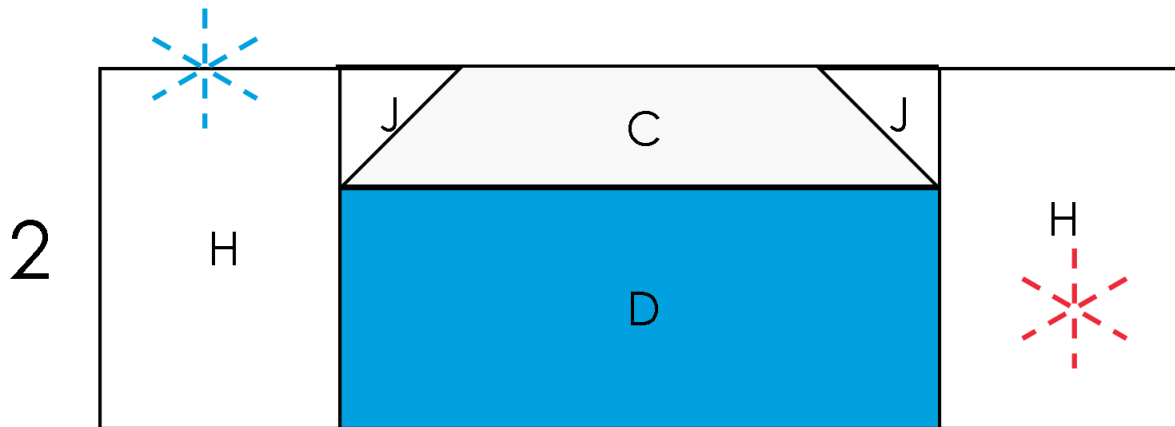
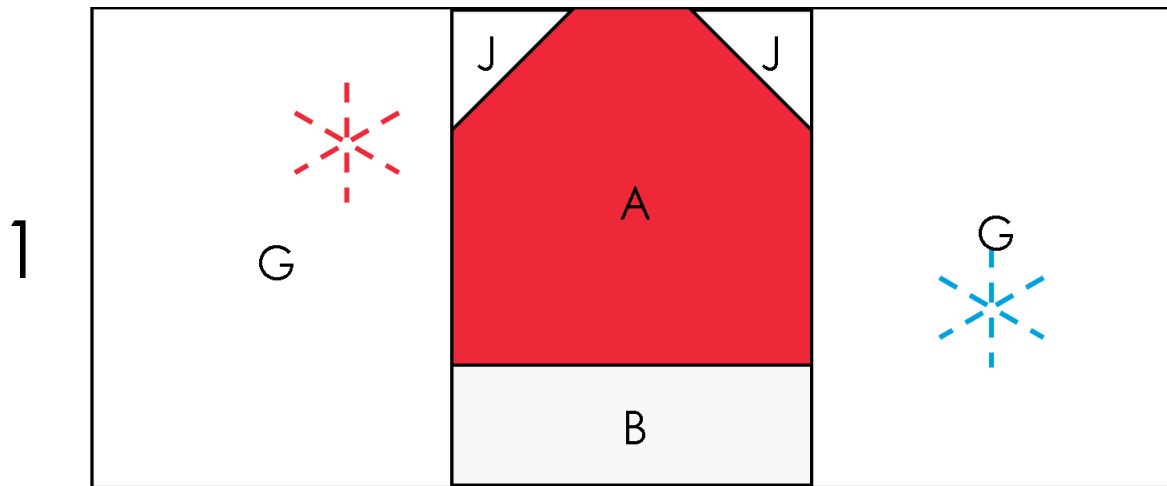
X 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 2

Y 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" 1

Z 2 1/2 x 3 1/2" 1



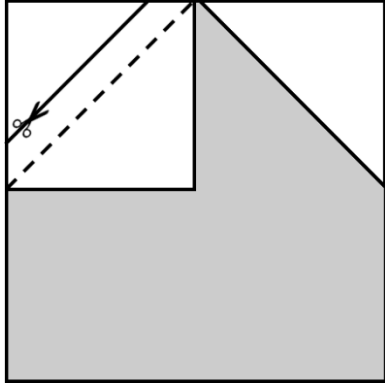
For this block, assemble sections, then stitch those sections together to make the ice pop. Every time you put two pieces together, the right sides of the fabric should be facing each other. Trim and press as you go.



Draw a diagonal line on the back of all J pieces.

Begin sewing with section 1. Lay one piece J even with the upper right corner of A. The line should follow the direction on the diagram. Stitch along the line, trim, and press.

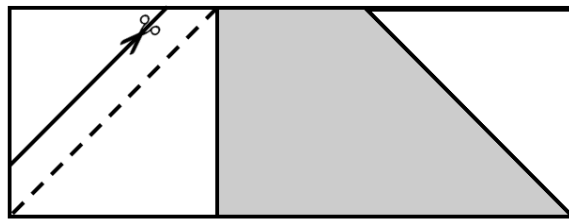
Repeat with a second piece J on the upper left corner of A.



Stitch piece B to the bottom edge of A.

Sew one piece G to each side of that unit to finish section 1.

For section 2, sew two J pieces to the two upper corners of C with the lines following the direction in the diagram.



Sew piece D to the bottom edge. Stitch one piece H to the right and left sides of the unit to complete section 2.

To make section 3, sew one I piece to either side of piece E.

Sew section 1 to 2, then add 3 at the bottom, as shown in the diagram.

Once your mug is finished, continue to the Mug Handle Assembly instructions. After adding the handle, sew both pieces V above and below the mug.

Transfer the July Ice Pop embroidery design to your block and stitch with perle cotton. Use a running stitch for the fireworks.
