

# Months of Mugs – November Cabin

Cut the following:

Medium Green

A 3 1/2 x 9 1/2" 1

Medium Brown

B 1 1/2 x 8 1/2" 1

C 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 3

D 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" 1

E 1 1/2 x 5 1/2" 1

Dark Brown

F 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 3

G 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" 1

H 1 1/2 x 5 1/2" 1

Red

I 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" 1

Yellow

J 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" 1

White (for mug)

K 1 1/2 x 9 1/2" 1

L 3 1/2 x 3 1/2" 2

M 1 x 5 1/2" 2

White (for handle)

S 1 1/2 x 1 1/2" 4

T 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" 2

U 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" 1

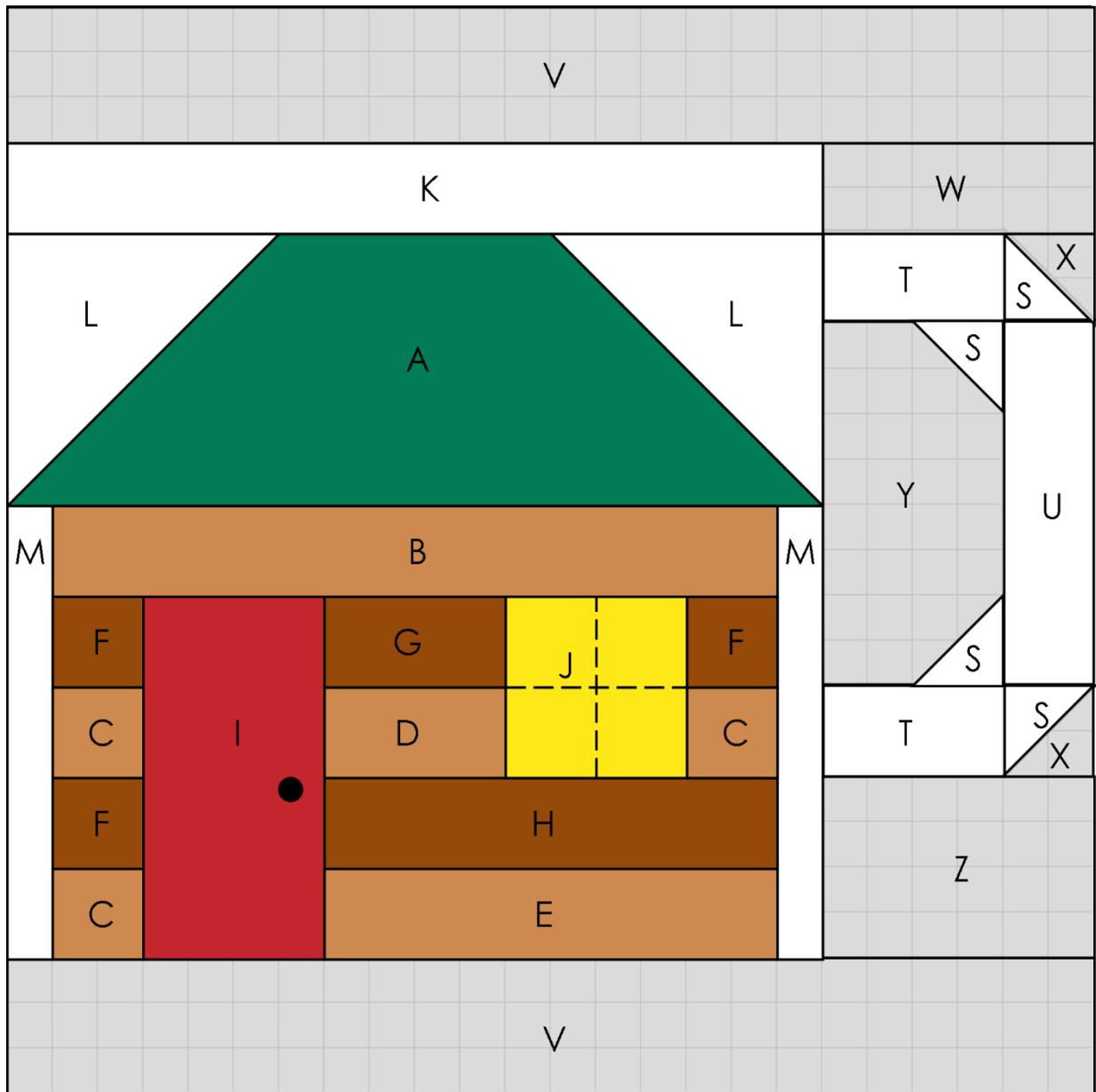

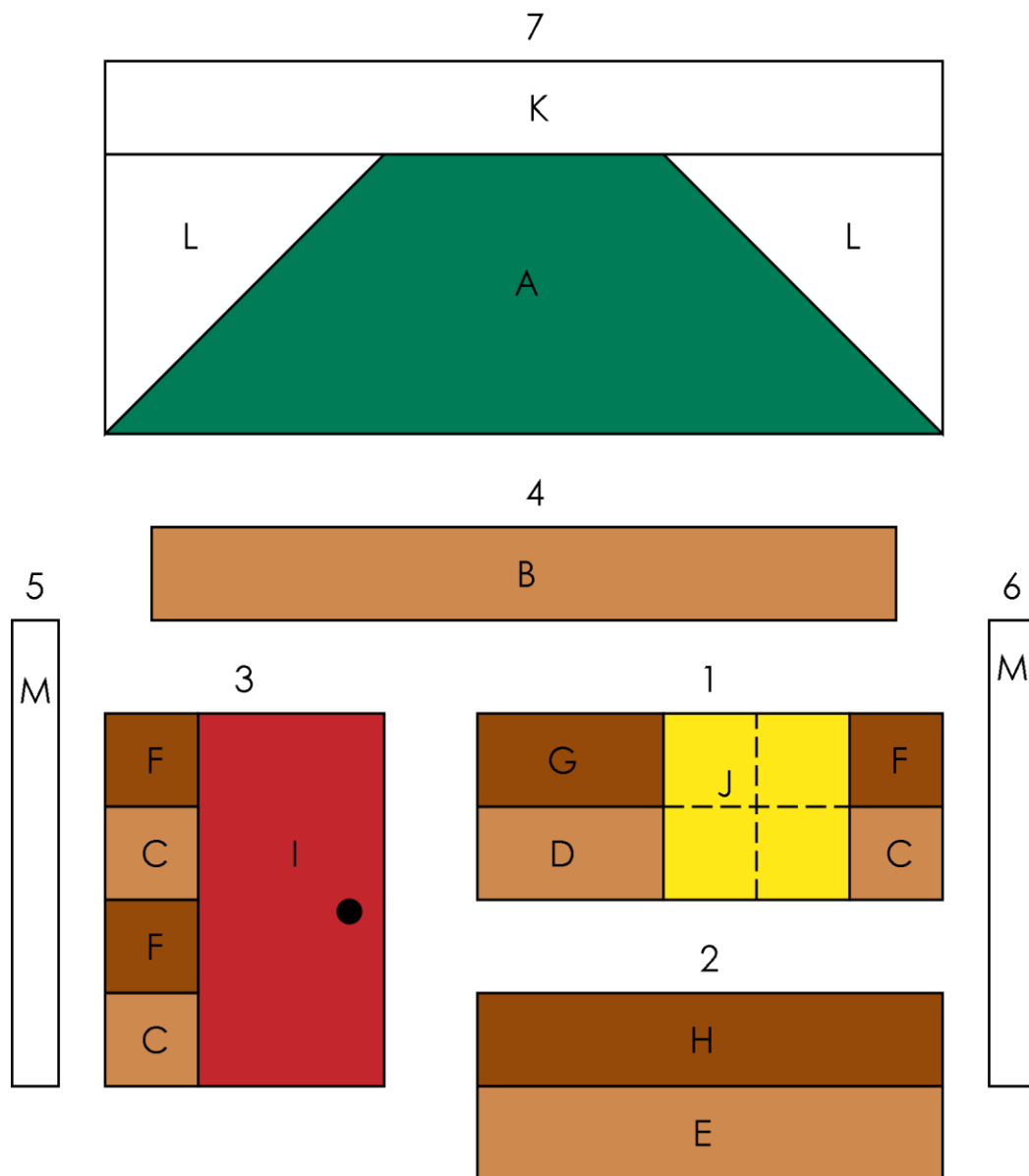

For this block, assemble sections, then stitch those together to make the cabin. Every time you put two pieces together, the right sides of the fabric should be facing each other. Trim and press as you go.



To make section 1, stitch one F to the upper edge of one C. Stitch G to the upper edge of D. Sew the F/C unit to the right hand edge of J, and the G/D unit to the left.

Section 2 is made by simply stitching H to the upper edge of E.

Start section 3 by stitching two pieces F and two C into an alternating row with F on the upper edge. Sew that unit to the left hand edge of I.

Sections 4, 5, and 6 are single pieces.

For section 7, draw a diagonal line on the back of two pieces L. Stitch one to the left edge and one to the right of A with the lines following the diagram. Add K to the upper edge of the unit to complete the section.

To assemble the block, begin by sewing section 1 to 2. Add section 3 to the left hand side. Sew section 4 across the upper edge. Add section 5 to the left and 6 to the right. Complete the block by sewing section 7 to the upper edge.

Once your mug is finished, continue to the Mug Handle Assembly instructions. After adding the handle, sew both pieces V above and below the mug.

Transfer the November Cabin embroidery design to your block and stitch with perle cotton using a backstitch. Satin stitch a 3/8" circle for the doorknob, or sew an appropriate size button in place.
